#### Pre-Payment Tuition Discount

A two percent (2%) tuition discount will be given for any account that is paid in one initial payment on or before August 10.

Multi-child discount of \$500 for PK3 and K4 students with siblings enrolled at LOLCS. (Pre-K students are not eligible for the FTC scholarships.)
